

THE PUG BREED COUNCIL
CRITERIA FOR INCLUSION ON THE COUNCIL JUDGING LISTS

A1. For persons who have been approved by the Kennel Club to award CC's in the Breed, have completed their first appointment and have the support of the Pug Breed Council.

A2. For persons who fulfil all the requirements for list A3 and who have been assessed in accordance with the Kennel Club requirements and accepted by the Kennel Club for inclusion on List A2 and have the support of the Pug Breed Council.

A3. Breed Specialists: For persons with a minimum of seven years judging experience in the Breed and to have judged a minimum of 170 Pugs within 60 classes and who have also fulfilled all current requirements of the Pug Breed Councils B list. To have bred and/or owned a minimum of three Pugs when they obtained their first entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances). In the case of joint ownership, the Pug must have remained as such for two years after gaining its studbook number. To have stewarded on a minimum of twelve days at Shows and have the support of the Pug Breed Council. To have attended and passed an Advanced Level Pug Breed Seminar run by a member Club.

A3. Non Specialists: For persons with a minimum of seven years judging experience in any one breed to include five years in pugs and to have judged a minimum of 180 Pugs within 60 classes and who have also fulfilled all current requirements of the Pug Breed Councils B list.. To have awarded CC's in another breed and have the support of the Pug Breed Council. To have attended and passed an Advanced Level Pug Breed Seminar run by a member Club.

B. Breed Specialists: For persons who have judged forty (40) or more Pugs in twenty classes over a minimum period of five years and have the support of the Pug Breed Council. To have passed a Basic Level Pug Breed Seminar run by a member Club. To have attended Seminars given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the relevant examinations on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures, Confirmation and Movement and The Points of the Dog Assessment.

B. Non Specialists: For persons who have judged forty (40) or more Pugs in twenty classes over a minimum period of five years and have the support of the Pug Breed Council. To have passed a Basic Level Pug Breed Seminar run by a member Club. If applicable, to have attended Seminars given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the relevant examinations on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures, Confirmation and Movement and The Points of the Dog Assessment.

C. Breed Specialists: To have shown an interest in the breed but do not qualify for list B. The minimum requirement being that candidates must have been a Pug Breed Club member for a minimum of two years and have attended a Pug Breed Seminar run by a member Club in accordance with the Kennel Club Code of Best Practice.

C. Non Specialists: To have shown an interest in the breed but do not qualify for list B. The minimum requirement being that candidates must have attended and passed a Basic Level Pug Breed Seminar run by a member Club.

Critiques

The Pug Breed Council expects all their approved Judges to submit a critique to the Dog Press within four weeks of a judging appointment. Failure to provide such a critique without written explanation of the relevant and extenuating circumstances to the Council Chairperson or Secretary may result in the Judges name being withheld from future lists.

Key to Information on the Judging Lists

CC indicates awards CC's or Green stars in other Breeds.

BS.1 indicates having attended Breed Specific Seminar

BS.2 indicates having attended & passed Breed Specific Basic Level Seminar

BS.3 indicates having attended & passed Breed Specific Advanced Level Seminar

KCE.1 indicates having passed examinations on Confirmation and Movement.

KCE.2 indicates having passed The Points of the Dog Assessment.

KCE.3 indicates having passed Requirements of a Dog Show Judge.

ST indicates Stewarding qualifications fulfilled.

NS indicates non specialist Judge.
